





Full cycle service POLICY

FULL CYCLE SERVICE (FSC) POLICY is the innovational solution in providing services to participants. FSC is a full spectrum of works with our participants and their documents, from pre-screening of their applications and processing all the necessary visa documents to meeting them at destinations points and transferring them to the places of orientation, accommodation and their future work.



When applicants become participants, they experience a really friendly attitude. We inform them about all stages of their participation, their responsibility before the employer, about the labour and immigration legislation of the country they go to. They learn about the unfamiliar customs, traditions and climate they will be required to adapt to. We help them in collecting of all the necessary documents, we meet with their work or academic administration and we solve conflicts in their places of work or study, we accompany them to embassies,

we organize pre-departure orientations, we provide them with air tickets, we fly together with them or we meet them at foreign airports, we inform them on their routes to their future employers. And finally, we always keep for our participants 24-hour emergency assistance running.



ROSPERSONAL history

ROSPERSONAL is a child of 2000 Millennium, in the year when a New Century begun running it was just a dream of a few friends, united by creating affordable cultural exchange opportunities.

In 2000 a few future ROSPERSONAL leaders met in Moscow to create the agency of an essentially new formation which work would be based on personal experience of leaders in working abroad. All of us have committed ourselves to working in different countries under different work permit schemes and cultural exchange programs.

In 2001 ROSPERSONAL was registered as a limited liability company with branches in different Russian cities, and the first ROSPERSONAL license for employment of Russian citizens abroad was issued. As a staff provider for more than 20 EU companies, ROSPERSONAL has developed a reputation for the high quality of service for both our participants and our partners. This great reputation comes from our past participants, with their great attitude, work ethic and abilities.

In 2002 web portal www.rospersonal.ru begun running its hi-tech engines which have allowed employers and applicants to search for each other, filling up a database incredibly quickly. Soon this web portal became a source of constantly updated information on all questions of labour and immigration legislation together with a magnificent tape of the world news translated into Russian.

In 2003 ROSPERSONAL with support of personnel agencies, lawyers, educational establishments and migratory services of Great Britain and Spain has organized a seminar in London titled "Labour migration. Statistics. Legislation. Prospects." Since then ROSERSONAL has started its successful all-Russia promotion of the educational and labour programs such as: Language Courses in British and Spanish colleges, SBSTWS - seasonal work in the hotel and food processing industry for unskilled young adults, SAWS - seasonal work for youth on farms, TWES - training in hotels, HSMP - the highly skilled migrant program, and etc. In the same year ROSERSONAL begun realizing an inbound program Volunteer in Russia to give invaluable help to Russian children in summer camps, orphanages, youth organizations and rehabilitation centers in 45 cities of Russia, in the country's central or northern parts, in the Far East or on the coasts of the south.

In 2004 Seminar in Verona "Work and Education in Italy" was organized and devoted to students programs and programs of the international students' exchange, with number of meetings with representatives of educational establishments, organizations of vocational training, language, musical and art schools.

In the same year ROSPERSONAL teamed up with travel agency Travel Centre, information agency INFO-DIGEST and a Translation Centre to make Full Cycle Service Policy available to all our participants.

In 2005 ROSPERSONAL has leaded two Cross-Culture Interexchange Weeks, in Nicosia, Cyprus, and in Chicago, USA. Those events gave an opportunity to avoid the intermediaries in promoting Work Permits Schemes of Cyprus, Work and Travel USA, Camp USA, and to make the cost of the programs more accessible to youth.

In 2006 ROSPERSONAL has been creating new programs for Russian participants within Greek and Spanish hospitality sector which has always had a huge demand for seasonal staff during summer holidays of Russian students.

In 2007 ROSPERSONAL begun realizing the programs of Internship and Live-in Caregiver in Canada and language course and educational program in New Zealand. In the same year ROSPERSONAL has open a few offices for consulting services of foreign citizens in Russia in Cheboksary, Ulyanovsk, and Moscow. In the same year ROSPERSONAL have begun running new web projects: www.transtale-centre.ru, www.work-n-travel.ru, www.volunteer-in-russia.com. We are still open for cooperation, for researching and implementation of new opportunities for youth to open the world in a fun, safe and useful way.

Design your own volunteer project

Just follow all the seven steps below and you can design your own project of work and travel in Russia from 4 weeks to 2 years.

Step 1 Learn what it means to be a volunteer

You can be considered a volunteer if you:

- do not expect to get profit for your help.
- can do without government support, i.e. pay all the costs yourself for the organization of the work you are doing free of charge.
- are ready to help with your personal convictions, sincerely and with love.



You can become a volunteer if you:

- are 18+ at the departure.
- are physically and mentally healthy and can prove it by certificate of health translated into Russian and certified notarially and by apostil.
- can understand and speak Russian well enough to work where you've chosen (it's not necessarily for staff members).
- have communication skills for working with children (for counselors and mentors) and can prove it by references from your work or by pictures with your younger brothers or sisters.

If you are with us, you are not alone:

- Today more than one hundred million people are members of the volunteerism.
- 19% of adults in France participated at least once in their lives in volunteer actions.
- Every third German that is 34 % of the population of Germany is a volunteer devoting more than 15 hours per month to work in the volunteer associations, projects and groups of mutual aid.
- 26% of Japanese have the volunteer experience in the past and they are sure that volunteer work is very useful for their personal growth and for the society on the whole.
- About 33% of the population in Ireland are volunteers. The time spent on volunteer work amounts to 96,454 working hours per year. 72 % of the population think that volunteers do something that can never be done by the hands of paid employees.

Decide which cities are in the top of your list



Moscow, the capital of Russia

Moscow is the capital of Russia. It's one of the biggest megapolis of the world and the biggest city of Europe. The population according to the latest census is about 10 million people. In fact in Moscow live about 15 million people.



Cheboksary, Central, Russia

Cheboksary is the capital of Chuvashia with the population of about 500 thousand people. The city of Cheboksary is thought to be one of the most inhabitable and culturally rich cities in

Russia. In Cheboksary and Samara, natural beauty not only blesses the city, but also its people. The unique wisdom of centuries gone by coexists alongside the glamour of European refinement, the mesmerizing charm of intricate cloths, and the melodic sounds of the Chuvash melodies.



Anapa, the Black Sea coast

The city of Anapa with the population of 53.000 people is conveniently situated on the coast of the Black Sea where the Great Caucasus Mountain range begins, where people have been enjoying the

combination of sun and sea, steppe, mountain, maritime climate and the purest healing air for thousands of years.



Kazan, Central Russia

The city of Kazan is symbolic of a thousand year connection that has joined the East to the West, not only demographically, but also spiritually. The city manages to successfully balance and intertwine its Muslim and Christian traditions, which coexist as a complement to one another. It's a population of 1.110.000 people.



Ulyanovsk, Central Russia

Ulyanovsk with its population of 623.000 has established itself as the "green" capital of Russia's Volga region. There are parks galore in this city. The ancient streets are

compelling, as are the people and the sweet aroma of spring flowers. There is a sense of intelligence and high culture in this city, which seems to be passed down between generations.



Rostov-na-Donu, Southern Russia

Rostov-na-Donu is a port of five seas, a big industrial, scientific and cultural southern center of the country, important road junction with the

population of more than 1 million people. It's a typical southern city with numerous squares and parks, beaches and primeval country nature, with sunlit avenues and seafront lights in the southern nights full of fragrances and mysteries.



Samara, Central Russia

Samara with its population of 1.133.000 people, with its high living standards, modern entertainment structure, and relative social comfort, has long been thought of as the second

Moscow. Here you will also find some of the most beautiful girls in Russia, brilliant sunshine, attractive nineteenth century homes, and contemporary skyscrapers housing up to date shopping centres.



Novorossiysk, The Black Sea

Novorossiysk is the biggest trade port in the south of Russia with the population of 250.000 people. The treasure of this region is the most beautiful lake Abrau that is the biggest,

cleanest and most beautiful lake in the North Caucasus. Every year Novorossiysk receives tens of thousands of tourists from northern regions of Russia and abroad. This is a real paradise for diving and surfing.

Step 3 Choose volunteer projects

Work in orphanages

In every Russian city there are several state orphanages for orphans from 4 to 18 years old. In fact these are boarding schools where children live, eat and study according to the general school program. You can work there as a mentor or a staff member. The buildings are situated within the city boundaries. Volunteers have to work 8 hours per day and five days per week. The program is open all the year round starting on Monday. The duration of the program is 4, 8, 12, 16 weeks. You can come for a smaller or larger period of time; in this case we'll make up the program and calculate the price especially for you.





Work in a children's summer camp

Every summer thousands of children head off for camps across Russia. Each camp has its own philosophy, but all provide children with a place to relax while having fun in an outdoor setting. In many ways, these camps resemble those in the UK. Typically, a camp will have a large dining hall, crafts and sports buildings and dormitories and children usually come for periods of 28 days. Many camp activities take place in the beautiful Russian countryside, often by a lake or river, which provides a glorious setting for swimming and boating. Other activities may include land sports, arts and crafts, performing arts (dance, theatre) and teaching. There are 2 positions on the Programme: Camp Counsellor or Volunteer Staff

Member. As a counsellor you are a teacher, a leader and a friend to a group of children between 8 and 16 years old. You are responsible for the safety and well being of your group and for providing them with the time of their lives! As a volunteer staff member you help with a number of aspects of running the camp, including cleaning, washing and cooking and actually making the Camp functional. The schedule of the beginning of sessions is advertised by camps in the beginning of May. The duration of the program is 4, 8, 12, 16 weeks. You can come for a smaller or larger period of time; in this case we'll make up the program and calculate the price especially for you. The session usually lasts for 28 days and then comes another one. Camps are

usually open from June, 1 to September, 24.

Work in a youth center

There are youth centers in all Russian cities. They can be called in different ways: from youth center to youth labour registry office, but all of them are municipal establishments of social services for teenagers and young people providing them with vocational job placements and extracurricular activities.



The program is open all the year round starting on Monday. The duration of the program is 4, 8, 12, 16 weeks. You can come for a smaller or larger period of time; in this case we'll make up the program and calculate the price especially for you.

Work in a rehabilitation center



In every Russian city there are several state Rehabilitation Centers for socially unprotected children and physically disabled children from 4 to 18 years old. These are boarding schools where children live, eat, have therapy and study according to the general school program during 2-6 months. You can work there as a mentor or a staff member. The buildings are situated within the city boundaries. Volunteers have to work 8 hours a day and five days a week. The program for working with physically disabled children is open all the year round starting on every Monday.

Work with socially unprotected children can start on every Monday in summer time from May till August. The duration of the program is 4, 8, 12, 16 weeks. You can come for a smaller or larger period of time; in this case we'll make up the program and calculate the price especially for you.

Step 4 Decide what would you like to do



Besides working in volunteer projects you certainly can just travel and these travels can become a part of your "Russian project".

In volunteer projects we offer you two positions: counselor/mentor or staff member. As a counsellor you are a teacher, a leader and a friend to a group of children from 4 to 16 years old. In the summer camp you are responsible for the safety and a good way of spending time of your group. During academic year from September till May you can teach a language in the day-time in universities and schools. As a staff member you'll clean,

wash, cook and serve and actually help to make the camp/orphanage, etc. functional.

If you are a counselor/mentor, you:

• teach children English, German, Spanish or French every working day



- accompany children to treatment
- walk with children (baby carriage is used for small children)
- play with children in a special play room
- learn songs, dances, jokes
- help to prepare for different holidays and festivals
- participate and organize classes in hobby groups
- organize sport activities (football, badminton)
- tell children about your country





Step 5
Think how much you can spend on your project

Assess your costs for the travel, how much you can pay for it and how much you can spend while traveling. Our experienced travel adviser will help you in your calculations and all the recommendations concerning your travel.

Step 6
Schedule the time
of your travel



You can combine your travel and work in summer time in children's camps and rehabilitation centers and work as a teacher of English, German, Spanish or French at schools and universities in winter time. Don't forget that our travel department can offer you very interesting excursions and just tours around Russia. Decide for how long you would like to stay in every city and project, how long time it will take you to travel in Russia on the whole. Try to determine the date of your arrival and departure from each city. Remember that work in children's camp starts from the end of May and lasts till the end of September, and the school year in schools and universities begins in September and lasts till May, and that the best time to travel in Russia is summer.

Step 7
Talk it through
with a travel advisor

Once you have thought about steps 1 - 6 and you have a good idea about your own volunteer project, call or email Volunteer in Russia and talk the trip through with a travel advisor. Advisors are young, have taken volunteer work and are experts in what they do. They will help you choose the best routes; the best projects and will put together a great itinerary and price for you.
